### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:


**SECTION 1**: Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is amended by changing all the B1-2 Neighborhood Shopping District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 7-F in the area bounded by:

West Wrightwood Avenue;
North Orchard Street;
the alley next south of and parallel with West Wrightwood Avenue;
a line 26 feet west of and parallel with North Orchard Street

to those of RM5 Residential Multi-Unit District, which is hereby established in the area above described.

**SECTION 2**: This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and due publication.
