ORDINANCE FOR ACCEPTANCE OF BID FROM DAVID A. BECK FOR PURCHASE OF BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE CITY OF CHICGO PROPERTY AT 13311 SOUTH BURLEY AVENUE

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago (the "City"), is a home rule unit of government under Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and, as such, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the City of Chicago (the "Board"), is a body corporate and politic, organized under and existing pursuant to Article 34 of the School Code of the State of Illinois, 105 ILCS 5/1-1, et seq. (the "School Code"); and

WHEREAS, The Board is the beneficial owner of real estate located at 13311 South Burley Avenue, Chicago, Illinois as legally described on Exhibit A, attached hereto (the Property"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Number 19-1211-OP1 (the "Resolution"), adopted by the Board on December 11, 2019, the Board approved the sale of the Property; and

WHEREAS, the title to the Property is currently held by the City, as Trustee, in Trust for the Schools; and

WHEREAS, the Resolution includes a request to the City Council of the City of Chicago to sell said Property in accordance with Section 34-21(d)(1) of the School Code; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34-21(b)(1) of the School Code, by vote of no less than two-thirds (2/3) of its full membership, the Board has determined that the Property has become unnecessary, unsuitable, and unprofitable for the use of the schools or for the purposes of school administration, and that the sale of the Property constitutes the best available use of such real estate for the purpose of deriving revenue to support the Board's authorized purposes; and

WHEREAS, the value of the Property is less than Twenty- Five Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$25,000.00) and therefore does require a competitive bid; and

WHEREAS, the Board solicited bids for the Property and received one bid from the adjacent owner for Three Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$3,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Board has, by a vote of not less than two-thirds of its full membership at its meeting on December 11, 2019, recommended that the acceptance of the bid from David A. Beck ("Bidder") in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$3,000.00) be accepted; now, therefore,

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

- Section 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby adopted as the findings of the City Council.
- **Section 2.** The City of Chicago hereby accepts David A. Beck's bid to purchase the Property described on Exhibit A in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$3,000.00).
- Section 3. The Mayor or her proxy is authorized to execute and the City Clerk or the Deputy Clerk is authorized to attest, a Quit Claim Deed conveying to David A. Beck all right, title and interest of the City, as Trustee, in Trust for the Use of Schools in and to the Property subject to the Use Restrictions in substantially the following form:
- Section 4. The interest of the Board and the City, as Trustee, in Trust for the Use of Schools, in and to the Property conveyed in its "AS IS-WHERE IS" condition, and the deed conveying such interest shall provide that the City and the Board are to be released and discharged from any and all responsibility or liability with respect to the Property's physical, structural and environmental condition.
- Section 5. The Mayor, the City Clerk, and the Commissioner of the Department of Assets, Information & Services (the "Commissioner"), or a designee of the Commissioner, are each authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City such supporting documents and certificates and to do such other things consistent with the terms of this Ordinance as such officers and employees shall deem necessary or appropriate in order to implement the provisions of this Ordinance.
- **Section 6.** If any provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.
- Section 7. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
 - **Section 8.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
