11	West 37th Street (east leg) and South Morgan Street; All Way Stop, Stopping All Approaches [O2020-2566]
11	West 25th Place and South Morgan Street; All Way Stop, Stopping All Approaches [O2020-2569]
35	North Hamlin Avenue and West Windsor Avenue; All Way Stop, Stopping Approaches [Or2020-146]

**SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.**


