*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to SALERNO'S, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use thirteen (13) Light Fixture(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1201 W. Grand Ave..

Said Light Fixture(s) at W. GRAND AVE measure(s):

Four (4) at point five (.5) feet in length, point seven five (.75) feet in width and ten (10) feet above grade level.

One (1) at point six seven (.67) feet in length, one (1) foot in width and ten (10) feet above grade level.

Six (6) at one point three three (1.33) foot in length, one point five (1.5) foot in width and ten (10) feet above grade level.

One (1) at one point zero four (1.04) foot in length, six point zero four (6.04) feet in width and nine point five (9.5) feet above grade level.

One (1) at point five (.5) feet in length, one point seven six (1.76) foot in width and ten (10) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).


This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1145688 herein granted the sum of one hundred thirty-five (\$135.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.






