ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by designating as a Pedestrian Retail Street with the appropriate symbols and indications that segment of the North Lincoln Avenue Right-of-Way on Map No. 7-G in the area bounded by:

the centerline of West Diversey Avenue on the south and the centerline West Belmont Avenue on the north,

as a Pedestrian Retail Street.

SECTION 2. Section 17-3-0503-D of Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language, as follows:

17-3-0503-D [Pedestrian Streets and Pedestrian Retail Streets.]
