#### TRAFFIC LANE - TOW ZONES

### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Traffic Lane – Tow Zones, between the limits and during the times specified, standing or parking of any vehicle shall be considered a definite hazard to the normal movement of traffic:

WARD	TOWZONES:
11	South Racine Avenue(east and west sides) from West 35th Street to West Pershing Road; No Parking Tow Zone, 9:00pm to 5:00am, All Days[O2020-3003]
39	North Pulaski Road (east and west sides) from West Peterson Avenue to West Ardmore Avenue; No Parking Tow Zone, All Times, All Days[O2020-3004]
42	North Rush Street (west side) from a point 60 feet north of East Hubbard Street to a point 20 north thereof; Columbian Consulate Parking Only, No Parking Tow Zone [O2019-9543
42	West Hubbard Street (north side) from North Wells Street to a Point 50 feet west thereof; No Parking Tow Zone, All Times, All Days — (20-0239640) [O2020-139]
42	North side of West Lake Street, from a point approximately 100 feet west of North State Street, to a point 20 feet west thereof;(Consulate Parking Only) No Parking Tow Zone, All Times, All Days[O2020-3519]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
