TRAFFIC WARNING SIGN AND/OR SIGNALS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, that the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to erect and/or amend Traffic Warning Signs and Signals, for the following locations are hereby designated:

WARD	TRAFFIC WARNING SIGNS AND/OR SIGNALS:
4	East 40th Street from South Drexel Boulevard to South Lake Park Avenue, Single direction Easterly -19-02113896 [O2019-8601]
11	South Lyman Street and South Arch Street, All Way Stop Sign, Stopping All Approaches [Or2020-131]
12	West 33rd Street from South Ashland Avenue to a point 146 feet west thereof: (first alley west of South Ashland Avenue) Single Direction (easterly) All Times, All Days (20-02396500) [O2020-336]
22	South Harding Avenue and West 24th Street, All Way Stop, Stopping All Approaches19-01914318 [O2019-7119]
27	South Halsted Street, (west side) from a point 85 feet south of West Madison Street to a point 50 feet south thereof. No Parking Taxi Stand Tow Zone, All Times, ALL Days (20-02396172) [O2020-306]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
