Amendment of Municipal Code Title 2 to modify powers and duties of Commissioners of Department of Transportation and Department of Water Management concerning post-construction restoration

ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 2-102-030 and 2-106-040 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored, and by deleting the language struck through, as follows:

2-102-030 Commissioner – Powers and duties.

The Commissioner of Transportation shall have the following powers and duties:

- (aa) The powers and responsibilities listed here shall be implemented followed by proper efforts to ensure the visual aesthetics and horticultural viability of the post-construction restoration are successful as defined by a uniform restoration policy promulgated and adopted in conjunction with the City Council, Department of Water Management, Department of Procurement Services and the Office of Budget Management.


2-106-040 Commissioner – Power and duties.

The Commissioner of Water Management shall have the following powers and duties:

- (p) The powers and responsibilities listed here shall be implemented followed by proper efforts to ensure the visual aesthetics and horticultural viability of the post-construction restoration are successful as defined by a uniform restoration policy promulgated and adopted in conjunction with the City Council, Department of Transportation, Department of Procurement Services and the Office of Budget Management.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication.
