#### **ORDINANCE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1 Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by changing all of RS-3 Residentials Single-Unit (Detached Home) District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 26-B in the area bounded by:

A line 135.20 feet south of and parallel to east 103<sup>rd</sup> street; South Torrence Avenue; a line 210.2 feet south of and parallel to east 103<sup>rd</sup> street; and, the public alley next west South Torrence Avenue.

to those of a B3-1 Community Shopping District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.






# PLAT OF SURVEY
