#20569 INTRO DATE DEC 16, 2020

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning

Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the RT-4 Residential Two-Flat,

Townhouse and Multi-Unit District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 7-G

in an area bound by

West Barry Avenue; North Racine Avenue; a line 24.98 feet south of and parallel to

West Barry Avenue; And the public alley next west of and parallel to North Racine

Avenue


