## **ORDINANCE**

### **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

**SECTION 1.** On September 9, 2020, the City Council of the City of Chicago passed an ordinance, referenced as SO2020-4101, published on pages 20678 through 20681 of the Journal of Proceedings of the City Council for that date ("Ordinance"). SECTION 1 and SECTION (4)(b) of the Ordinance, which appears on page 20680 of that Journal, are hereby amended by deleting the language stricken and by inserting the language underlined as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any more restrictive provision in Title 17 of the Code, public safety services that provide temporary government-authorized fire, police or life protection services are allowed in the following locations when such services are required to assist in responding to the Emergency:

- (i) ~~8131 S. May Street (Calumet High School); and~~
- (ii) 2641 S. Calumet Avenue (Young Women's Leadership Academy).

(b) SECTION 1 of this ordinance shall be repealed of its own accord, without further action of the City Council, on ~~March 1, 2021~~ July 1, 2021.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
