Amendment of Municipal Code Title 2 to modify powers and duties of Commissioners of Department of Transportation and Department of Water Management regarding post-construction restoration

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Section 2-102-030 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored as follows:

2-102-030 Commissioner - Powers and duties.

The Commissioner of Transportation shall have the following powers and duties:

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

- (bb) The materials and methods used for post-construction restoration shall be uniform throughout the City and be, at minimum, consistent with industry standards; provided, however, that post-construction restoration of right of way within the jurisdiction of the Illinois Department of Transportation shall comply with the Illinois Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction.

SECTION 2. Section 2-106-040 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the language underscored, and by deleting the language struck through, as follows:

2-106-040 Commissioner - Power and duties.

The Commissioner of Water Management shall have the following powers and duties:

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

- (q) The materials and methods used for post-construction restoration shall be uniform throughout the City and be, at minimum, consistent with industry standards; provided, however, that post-construction restoration of right of way within the jurisdiction of the Illinois Department of Transportation shall comply with the Illinois Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall apply only to contracts entered into after its effective date.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and publication.
