BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning
Ordinance is hereby amended by changing all of the RS3 Residential Single-Unit
(Detached House) District symbols as shown on Map No. 5-M
in the area bounded by:

A line 50 feet north of and parallel to West Dickens Avenue; the public alley next east of and parallel to North Monitor Avenue; West Dickens Avenue; and North Monitor Avenue.

To those of an M1-1 Limited Manufacturing/Business Park District

SECTION 2. This Ordinance takes effect after its passage and due publication.


