<u>ORDINANCE</u>

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, be amended by changing all the *RT-3.5 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District* symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 9-G in the area bounded by

West Patterson Avenue; the alley next southwest of and parallel to North Clark Street; the alley next north of and parallel to West Addison Street; and a line 284 feet east of and parallel to North Racine Avenue,

to those of a RM-5.5 Residential Multi-Unit District.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.

The Applicant is seeking a *Zoning Map Amendment* in order to permit the construction of a new four-story (with basement) multi-unit *residential* building, with an attached garage, at the subject property. To accommodate for the new development, the Applicant intends to raze the existing *non-conforming* structures, which presently occupy the site. The proposed new four-story building will contain a total of nineteen (19) dwelling units, located on and between the Basement (partial) thru 4th Floors. In addition to two of the dwelling units, the 1st Floor will feature interior (garage) parking for sixteen (16) vehicles and at least six (6) bicycles, at the rear and along the east side, which such parking will be accessible via the two Public Alleys bordering the site. The proposed new building will be masonry in construction and will measure 47 feet—0 inches in height.
