BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing the M3-3 Heavy Industry District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 5-G in the area bounded by

A line 98.7 feet southwesterly and parallel to West Homer Street; North Mendell Street; A line 200.25 feet southwesterly and parallel to West Homer Street; the alley next westerly and parallel to North Mendell Street

to those of a C3-3 Commercial, Manufacturing and Employment District

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.

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

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PROPOSED THIRD FLOOR PLAN

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
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
