Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to Greater Ravenswood Chamber of Commerce upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use one (1) Sculpture(s) on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 4758 N RAVENSWOOD AVE.

Said Sculpture(s) at N Revenswood Ave measure(s):

One (1) at four (4) feet in length and three (3) feet in width, for a total of twelve (12) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clark.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.


