# ORDINANCE

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, be amended by changing all the B3-1 Community Shopping District symbols and indications as shown on Map No.7-I in the area bounded by

West Belmont Avenue; a line 120 feet west of and parallel to North Francisco Avenue; the Public Alley next south of and parallel to Belmont Avenue; and a line 168 feet west of and parallel to North Francisco Avenue;

to those of a B2-3 Neighborhood Mixed-Use District is hereby established in the area above described.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.
