ORDINANCE Athletico Physical Therapy Acct. No.: 69020 - 24 Permit No: BACP1563598

Bo It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to Athletico Physical Therapy upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use one (1) Sign(s) projecting over the public right-of-way attached to its premises known as 423 E OHIO ST.

Said Sign structure(s) measures as follows along E Ohio St: One (1) at thirty-eight point eight (38.8) feet in length, two point four (2.4) feet in height and ten (10) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #BACP 1563598 herein granted the sum of three hundred (\$300.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.






