Kitchen + Kocktails by Kevin Kelley

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to Kitchen + Kocktails by Kevin Kelley upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use two (2) Sign(s) projecting over the public right-of-way attached to its premises known as 444 N WABASH AVE.

Said Sign structure(s) measures as follows along 444 N Wasbash Avenue:

Two (2) at five point four (5.4) feet in length, twenty (20) feet in height and twenty-one point four (21.4) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Zoning Department - Signs.

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #BACP1580919 herein granted the sum of six hundred (\$600.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 07/26/2021.

BLADE SIGN SPECIFICATIONS



SCOPE OF WORK: Remove the [12] existing faces from each blade sign and bring back to JNB shop
Using the existing faces as templates, manufacture [12] new faces with vinyl graphics and push-thru
letters as shown. Prep and paint the existing actioners on site.

ELECTRICAL: Sign will need to be on a dimmer switch per city code. Will need to run secondary electrical to each sign




Remove existing faces from [2] blade signs and bring back to JNO shap for patterning
