Section 1: Section 10-20-430 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to exempt Inner-City Muslim Action Network (IMAN) 1203 West 63rd Street, Chicago, IL 60636, from the provisions requiring barriers as a prerequisite to prohibit alley ingress and egress to parking facilities for premise address.

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
