SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized

and directed to install 2% Disabled and One Hour Parking signs at the below listed locations and remove No Parking Signs and Residential Permit Parking at the below listed locations:

26	2% Disabled Parking N. Spaulding Avenue (east side) from W. Cortland Street to a point 40 feet south thereof; reserved parking disabled (2%), 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday, tow zone - 13-00597733 [02013-894]
27	W. Fulton Market (south side) from a point 15 feet west of N. Carpenter to a point 59 feet west thereof; one hour parking, 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, Monday through Saturday -13-00607835 [Or2013-91]
