**SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to install and/or amend Truck Route Signs at the below listed locations:**

#### WARD MISCELLENEOUS:

27                      North Ogden Avenue; North Ogden Avenue between West Chicago Avenue and property at 952 West Chestnut Street, and North Peoria Street between West Chicago Avenue and property at 835 North Peoria Street; Illinois Department of Transportation recommends as Class II Truck Routes [02017-3925]
