SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend Two Hour Parking Restriction Signs at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLANEOUS:

19 South Walden Parkway; South Walden Parkway (east side) from a point 30 feet south

of West 99th Street to a point 170 feet thereof; 2 Hour Parking, 8:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through

Saturday [02017-6314]

45 3700-3799 North Kilbourn Avenue; 3700-3799 North Kilbourn Avenue (west side)

between North Milwaukee Avenue to a point 200 feet south from North Milwaukee Avenue; 2 Hour

Parking, 6:00am to 5:00pm, Monday through Friday [02017-6353]
