36            2800-2816 North Newland Avenue; 2800-2816 North Newland Avenue (west side) from a point 5 feet north of West Diversey Avenue to a point 5 feet south of alley; One Hour Parking, 8:00am to 6:00pm, Monday through Friday [02016-7133]
