

Lease Agreement.

b) With regard to construction projects and construction-related projects arising from the New Use and Lease Agreement, the working group shall examine how to maximize participation by diverse firms, and encourage growth, capacity-building, and a level playing field for firms of all sizes and backgrounds that reflect the diversity of the City of Chicago. The working group may include in its review the estimated dollar value of upcoming contracting opportunities with the goal of ensuring that project packages have been divided sufficiently to maximize participation of small and mid-sized prime and sub contractors. The working group may also review the processes and procedures for bidding projects.

c) The working group shall meet periodically and shall provide recommendations to the Commissioner and to the City Council. Such recommendations may include recommendations

for presentations to communities, "town hall" overview meetings, and other outreach plans to ensure that firms are aware of upcoming opportunities.

(d) The working group shall in no way be involved in specification development, bidding, evaluation of or recommendations regarding specific bids, or contract award, nor shall it have access to any non-public information. Any member of the working group who does have access to non-public information as part of the performance of his or her day-to-day duties shall not share or discuss any such information with any other member of the working group who does not.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage and approval.
