BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Executive Director of the Mayor's office of special events is hereby authorized and directed to issue all necessary permits free of charge, not withstanding other ordinances of the City of Chicago to the contrary,

To: Special Events Management

For: 2011 Oktoberfest

On the premises located at 3000 N. Lincoln and on Oakdale between Southport and Greenview

On the date and time of: September 23 between the hours of 5 p.m. until 10 p.m., September 24 between the hours of 11 a.m. until 10 p.m. and on September 25 between the hours of noon until 7 p.m.

All appurtenances thereto shall be used exclusively for charitable purposed and shall not be leased or otherwise used with a view to profit, and the work thereon shall be done in accordance with plans submitted and all of the appropriate provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago and departmental requirements of various departments of the City of Chicago, and said building(s) and all appurtenances thereto shall be constructed and maintained so that they shall comply in all respects with the requirements of the appropriate provisions of the Municipal Code of the City of Chicago for the issuance of all necessary permits and licenses.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.
