

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to an ordinance heretofore passed by the City Council which allows for the erection of honorary street-name signs, the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation shall take all necessary action for the standardization of South Archer Avenue, between South Hamlin and South Lawndale as " Gorale Podhalanscy Way."

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication.

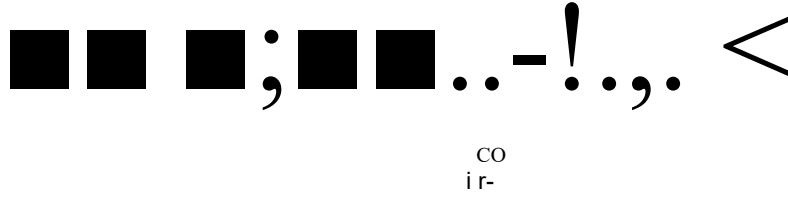

Institutional Biography

The Polish Highlanders Alliance of America is a national organization headquartered in Chicago, whose purpose is the continual unity of the peoples of Southern Poland. The organization was founded in November of 1928. Since that time, the Alliance has opened more than 86 small organizations and operated continually for 87 years.

In addition to the preservation and promotion of Highlander culture, the Alliance has operated its very own radio station, WPNA 1490, for over 30 years. In this way the linguistic heritage of the peoples of Southern Poland is promoted and shared, sometimes for the very first time, with new generations in the United States.
