ORDINANCE Verizon
Wireless Acct. No. 207988 -
74 Permit No. 1121053

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to Verizon Wireless, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use one (1) Occupation of Space (Small Cell Antenna) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 6600 N. Lightfoot Ave..

Said Occupation of Space (Small Cell Antenna) at N. Lightfoot measure(s):

One (1) at two point two five (2.25) feet in length, and two (2) feet in width for a total of four point five (4.5) square feet. Said small cell antenna shall be approximately thirty-two (32) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development, Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development), and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1121053 herein granted the sum of seventy-five (\$75.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after Date of Passage.

EXISTING WOOD POLE TO BE UTILIZED FOR MOUNTING PROPOSED LESSEE ANTENNA RRU AND EQUIPMENT PENDING STRUCTURAL ANALYSIS.

NOTE

1. LICENSEE'S ATTACHMENT TO COWED SOLELY OWNED POLES SHALL BE FLUSH MOUNTED AND AFFIXED WITH A "THROUGH BOLT" TYPE ATTACHING DEVICE THE "THROUGH BOLT" MAY NOT PROTRUDE MORE THAN 2" FROM THE POLE SURFACE "5 TO AVOID" INJURY TO THOSE WORKERS THAT CLIMB THE POLE TO MAINTAIN THE EQUIPMENT. COWED RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DENY THE USE OF ANY TYPE OF BRACKET PROPOSED BY THE LICENSEE TO SUPPORT ITS WIRELINE ATTACHMENTS.
2. WHEN BONDING IS REQUIRED ON JOINTLY OWNED POLES LICENSEE SHALL COORDINATE AND ARRANGE SUCH WITH JOINT OWNER. IF LICENSEE ELECTS TO HAVE BONDING BETWEEN LICENSEE AND JOINT OWNER FACILITIES PERFORMED LICENSEE SHALL DO SO UPON WRITTEN REQUEST TO JOINT OWNER (IF APPLICABLE).
3. ANTENNA AND POWER SUPPLY SHALL NOT BE INSTALLED ONTO POLES WITH STATIC WIRE ATTACHMENTS ONTO EXISTING FIBERGLASS POLE TOP EXTENSIONS OR ONTO POLES WHERE THEY PRESENT AN UNUSUAL CLIMBING HAZARD.
4. LICENSEE'S WIRELINE ATTACHMENTS SHALL NOT BE PLACED ON THE POLE AS THE COWED NEUTRAL CONDUCTOR AND JOINT OWNERS FACILITIES. LICENSEE SHALL ALWAYS INSTALL ITS FACILITIES ON THE SAME SIDE AS OTHER EXISTING COMMUNICATIONS FACILITIES. LICENSEE SHALL NOT PLACE INNERDUCT CONDUIT ETC ON THE POLE OR ON ITS STRAND. LICENSEE SHALL TERMINATE THESE FACILITIES AT THE BASE OF THE POLE AND SHALL BE ALLOWED TO PLACE A MAXIMUM OF ONE FOOT OF MATERIAL ABOVE GRADE AT THE BASE OF THE POLE. INNERDUCT CONDUIT ETC SHALL BE COVERED AND SECURED WITH THE APPROPRIATE GUARD PROTECTOR (FIBER DESIGN BY OTHERS UNDER SEPARATE PERMIT).
