AMEND - LOADING ZONE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1.

Repeal ordinance passed 11-29-89, page 8297 which reads W. Webster Ave. (ss) fap 65' east of N. Clifton Ave. tap 24' east thereof - Loading Zone, 6:00 P.M. to Midnight by striking the above 10-01564681 (PO2010-5465) (32nd Ward);

SECTION 2.

Amend Loading Zone, At All Times by striking 132' and inserting 85' related to W. Adams St. (ss) fap 182' west of S. LaSalle St. tap 60' west thereof 10-01581926 (PO2010-5414) (42nd Ward);

SECTION 3.

Repeal ordinance passed 6-7-00, page 35186 which reads W. Hubbard St. (ns) fap 20' west of N. State St. tap 20' west thereof -15 Minute Loading Zone Unattended Vehicles Must Have Lights Flashing, Tow Zone after 15 Minutes by striking the above 10-01374621 (PO2010-4814) (42nd Ward);

SECTION 4.

Repeal ordinance passed 2-6-91, page 30509 which reads W. Chestnut (ss) fap 30' east of N. Dearborn Pkwy. tap 35' east thereof - Loading Zone/Tow Zone by striking the above 10-01582085 (PO2010-5413) (42nd Ward);

SECTION 5.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in forced hereinafter its passage and publication.
