

WHEREAS, Rosey's long career encompassed a "who's who" of sports and national figures, and he was a walking encyclopedia of Chicago's sports teams and how WGN covered them; and

WHEREAS, Rosey was honored with multiple awards, including honors by the Chicago/Midwest chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences and the Illinois Broadcasters Association, and was recognized for his philanthropy by Swedish Covenant Hospital; and

WHEREAS, Jack Rosenberg died on December 26, 2020, at the age of 94; now, therefore BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO-SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 2-8-040 .of the Municipal Code of Chicago, which permits the erection of honorary street-name designations, the Commissioner of Transportation shall take all necessary action for standardization of North Cityfront Plaza Drive, from Illinois Street to E. North Water Street: as "Jack. Rosenberg; Way:"
