RESERVED PARKING (2% DISABLED)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to install and/or amend Reserved Parking (2% Disabled) Signs at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:

- 31 4428 W. Belden Avenue; W. Belden Avenue (north side) from a point 15 feet east of N. Kenneth Avenue to a point 20 feet east thereof; Reserved Parking (2% Disabled), All Times, Tuesday, Friday, & Sunday, Public Benefit - (14-02206480) [02014-10037]
- 42 101 E. Adams Street; E. Adams Street (south curb) from a point 100 feet west of N. Michigan Avenue to a point 25 feet west thereof; Reserved Parking (2% Disabled), All Times, All Days, Public Benefit [02015-6142]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
