

b) Exception for voting. If the Chicago Public Library or any branch thereof is used as a polling place for an election, a registered sex offender may enter such library for the limited purpose of voting if the registered sex offender is eligible to vote at that polling place.

c) Definitions. As used in this section:

"Registered sex offender" means any person who is registered or required to be registered as a sex offender under the Illinois Sex Offender Registration Act or under any federal or other jurisdictional law.

"Summer" means the period beginning on June 1 and ending on August 31.

d) Signage required. Signage shall be posted in a conspicuous place at each entrance to the Chicago Public Library and its branches notifying persons of the prohibition set forth in subsection (a) of this section. Such signage shall include the dates during which the prohibition is in effect.

e) Penally. Any person who violates subsection (a) of this section shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$500.00 nor more than \$ 1,000.00 for each offense. Each day that a violation continues shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take full force and effect ten days after its passage and publication.
