NO CRUISING ZONE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend No Cruising Zone Signs at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:

42 North Stetson Avenue; North Stetson Avenue from East Randolph Street to East Wacker Drive; North Columbus Drive from East Randolph Street to East Wacker Drive; East Upper Randolph Street from North Michigan Avenue to North Lake Shore Drive; East Lower Randolph Street from North Michigan Avenue to North Lake Shore Drive; East Upper Wacker Drive from North Michigan Avenue to North Lake Shore Drive; East Lower Wacker Drive from North Michigan Avenue to North Lake Shore Drive; No Cruising Zone, All Times, All Days [Or2015-472]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
