



Department's Bureau of Internal Affairs (BIA) involving a Department member alleged to have been a member of the Oath Keepers. The OIG found that BIA's analysis failed to address the applicability of CPD's Rules and Regulations and did not answer the question of whether the CPD member's membership in the Oath Keepers itself constitutes a violation of CPD policy and further recommended BIA reopen the investigation; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the resident of the city of Chicago, that CPD provides clarity as to whether a CPD member's membership in the Oath Keepers organization constitutes a violation of CPD policies and whether such membership could have negative impact on public safety and a negative public perception of the Department; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that Chicago Superintendent David Brown, BIA Chief Yolanda Talley, Inspector General Deborah Witzburg, and Deputy Inspector General - Public Safety Tobara Richardson, are hereby invited to appear before the Committee on Public Safety to provide testimony at a hearing on Chicago Police Department member's membership to the Oath Keeper's organization.
