### TRAFFIC WARNING SIGN AND/OR SIGNALS

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1.** Pursuant to Title 9, Chapter 64, of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the following locations are hereby designated as Traffic Warning Signs and Signals, between the limits and during the times specified, standing or parking of any vehicle shall be considered a definite hazard to the normal movement of traffic:

#### WARD                      TRAFFIC SIGNS AND SIGNALS:

- 14                      W. 53rd Street and S. Campbell Avenue; All Way Stop Sign [Or2014-75]
- 41                      W. Imlay Street and N. Normandy Avenue; All Way Stop, stopping all approaches - (13-01848792) [Or2013-389]

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
