ORDINANCE ZED 451

Acct. No. 1105228 No. 308380 -1 Permit

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to ZED 451, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Vault(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 739 N. Clark St..

Said Vault(s) at N. Clark Street measure(s):

One (1) at twenty-five (25) feet in length, and seventeen (17) feet in width for a total of four hundred twenty-five (425) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1105228 herein granted the sum of five hundred thirty (\$530.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.
