ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all of the Business-Residential Planned Development No. 559 District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 9-H in the area bounded

Line 210 feet north of West School Street; the alley next west of and parallel to North Ashland Avenue; a line 199.92 feet north of West School Street; North Ashland Avenue; a line 234.02 feet south of West School Street, as measured at the westerly right-of-way line of North Ashland Avenue; North Lincoln Avenue; and North Marshfield Avenue

to those of a Business-Residential Planned Development No. 559, as amended.

Section 2. This ordinance takes effect after its passage and approval.

1. The area delineated herein as Business-Residential Planned Development, as Amended, (the "Planned Development") consists of 88,658 square feet (2.04 acres) and is owned or controlled by the Applicant, Lincoln, Ashland & Belmont, L.L.C. ("Applicant") for this Planned Development.
2. The Applicant shall obtain all applicable official reviews, approvals or permits which are necessary to implement this Plan of Development. Any dedication or vacation of streets or alleys, or easements, or adjustments of right-of-way, or consolidation or resubdivision of parcels, shall require a separate submittal on behalf of the Applicant or its successors, assignees, or grantees and approval by the City Council. All conveyance of property to the City for public-right-of-way shall be through the City's dedication process.
3. The requirements, obligations and conditions applicable within this Planned Development shall be binding upon the Applicant, its successors and assigns and, if different than the Applicant, the legal title holders, any ground lessors and owners of all the property within the Planned Development succeed the Applicant for purposes of control and management of any portion of the Planned Development.
