ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. Chapter 4-244 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by adding the language underscored as follows: {

4-244-140 Prohibited Districts.

(a) No one having a peddler's license shall peddle any merchandise or any other article or thing whatsoever, at any time, within districts which have been or shall be hereafter designated by the city council. For districts which shall be kept on the premises of the clerk.

(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)

(28.) The east side of Western Avenue, from Broadway Street to a point 175 feet north of 83rd Street.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
