#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

**SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to establish and/or amend Two Hour Parking at the below listed locations:**

#### WARD TWO HOUR PARKING:

- 45 North Leamington Avenue (west side) from a point 45 feet south of North Elston Avenue to the first alley south thereof; Two-Hour Parking, 7:00am to 8:00pm Monday through Friday, and 7:30am to 3:00pm Saturdays - (19-02032654) [02019-8034]
- 48 900 West Thorndale Avenue (north and south sides) from North Sheridan Road to the Dead-End east thereof; Two Hour Parking, All Times, All Days - (19-01915728) [02019-7041]

**SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication. CHICAGO, DECEMBER 18, 2019**
