SECTION 1. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all the B3-2 Community Shopping District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 3-H in the area bounded by

A line 250 feet southeast of and parallel to North Honore Avenue or the line thereof if extended where no street exist; North Milwaukee Avenue; a line 275 feet southeast of and parallel to North Honore Avenue or the line thereof if extended where no street exists; and the alley next southwest of and parallel to North Milwaukee Avenue,

to those of a B3-3 Community Shopping District and a corresponding uses district is hereby established in the area above described.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.

In accordance with Amendment to the Zoning Code enacted by the City Council, Section 17-13-0107-A, please be informed that on or about September 5,2019,1, the undersigned, intend to file an application for a change in zoning from a B3-2 Community Shopping District to a B3-3 Community Shopping District, on behalf of the Applicant-Owner - 1460 N Milwaukee LLC, for the property located at 1460 North Milwaukee Avenue, Chicago, Illinois.

The Applicant is seeking a Zoning Map Amendment in order to permit the location and establishment of five (5) dwelling units, on and between the 2nd and 3rd Floors, of the existing three-story (frame) building, at the subject site. The 1st Floor of the existing building will continue to contain one (1) commercial-retail unit. The plan calls for the interior buildout of two (2) dwelling units on the 2nd Floor and three (3) dwelling units on the 3rd Floor - for a total of five (5) dwelling units, within the existing building. The plan does NOT call for the physical expansion of the exterior footprint or envelope of the existing building. 




