BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO,
SECTION 1. Section 9-64

390(h) of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended
by deleting the language struck through and by inserting the language underscored, as follows

9-64-090 Residential parking pei mit

(a) Subject to the approval of the city council, the commissioner of transportation is authorized to erect and maintain signs on any block of any residential street in an R1, R2, R3, R4 or R5 zoning district indicating residential permit parking only when all of the following conditions have been met:
