 CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION Acct. No.: 302602-41 Permit

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to CHICAGO BOARD OF EDUCATION upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use four (4) Fence(s) on the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 1744 W PRYOR AVE.

Said Fence(s) at S. Hermosa Ave measure(s):
 One (1) at eighty-five point two (85.2) feet in length and one (1) feet in width for a total of eighty-five point two (85.2) square feet.
 One (1) at sixty-five point nine (65.9) feet in length and one (1) feet in width for a total of sixty-five point nine (65.9) square feet.

Said Fence(s) at S. church St measure(s):
 One (1) at five hundred thirty-three point six (533.6) feet in length and one (1) feet in width for a total of five hundred thirty-three point six (533.6) square feet.

Said Fence(s) at W. Pryor Ave measure(s):
 One (1) at two hundred thirty-one point eight (231.8) feet in length and one (1) feet in width for a total of two hundred thirty-one point eight (231.8) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #BACP1551057 herein granted the sum of Zero (\$0.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.

Authority herein given and granted for a period of five (5) years from and after 11/01/2020.
