ORDINANCE
EXTRA SPACE STORAGE #1810 Acct. No.
299487 - 25 Permit No. 1143164

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to EXTRA SPACE STORAGE #1810, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to construct, install, maintain and use ten (10) Light Fixture(s) projecting over the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 601-635 W. Harrison St..

Said Light Fixture(s) at W. HARRISON ST measure(s):
Five (5) at one point zero eight (1.08) foot in length, point seven five (.75) feet in width and sixteen point six seven (16.67) feet above grade level.

Said Light Fixture(s) at S. DES PLAINES ST measure(s):
One (1) at one (1) foot in length, one (1) foot in width and fifteen point four six (15.46) feet above grade level. Two (2) at one point zero eight (1.08) foot in length, point seven five (.75) feet in width and sixteen point six seven (16.67) feet above grade level.

Said Light Fixture(s) at S. JEFFERSON ST measure(s):
Two (2) at one point zero eight (1.08) foot in length, point seven five (.75) feet in width and sixteen point six seven (16.67) feet above grade level.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Division of Project Development).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1143164 herein granted the sum of one

hundred twenty (\$120.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
