ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Chicago ("City") is a home rule unit of government by virtue of the provisions of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, and, as such, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, the City is the owner of the vacant parcels of property located at 4652-58 West Polk Street, Chicago, Illinois 60644, which are legally described on Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Properties"); and

WHEREAS pursuant to ordinances adopted by the City Council of the City of Chicago ("City Council") on February 5, 1999, and published at pages 60917 through 61070 in the Journal of Proceedings of the City Council ("Journal") for such date, the City Council approved a certain redevelopment plan and project for the Roosevelt Cicero Industrial Corridor Redevelopment Project Area; and

WHEREAS, Jakacki Bag & Barrel, Inc. (the "Grantee"), with a business address of 4607 West Lexington Street, Chicago, Illinois 60644, has offered to purchase the Properties from the City for the sum of Forty Seven Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$47,000.00), such amount being the appraised fair market value of the Properties, to improve with Industrial Open Space thereon; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 18-001-21 adopted on January 18, 2018, by the Plan Commission of the City (the "Commission"), the Commission approved the negotiated sale of the Properties to the Grantee; and

WHEREAS, public notice advertising the City's intent to enter into a negotiated sale of the Properties with the Grantee and requesting alternative proposals appeared in the Chicago Sun-Times, a newspaper of general circulation, on December 6 and 13, 2018; and

WHEREAS, no alternative proposals were received by the deadline indicated in the aforesaid notice; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. The City Council of the City hereby approves the sale of the Properties to the Grantee for the amount of Forty Seven Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$47,000.00),

SECTION 2. The Mayor or his proxy is authorized to execute, and the City Clerk or Deputy City Clerk is authorized to attest, a quitclaim deed conveying the Properties to the Grantee. Such deed shall include a covenant obligating the Grantee to use the Properties only for use consistent with the land uses permitted under the redevelopment plan for the Area. Grantee's acceptance of the City's deed shall constitute Grantee's agreement to such covenant. The quitclaim deed shall also contain language substantially in the following form:

This conveyance is subject to the express condition that: the Properties are improved with Industrial landscaped open space within six (6) months of the date of this deed.

In the event that the condition is not met, the City of Chicago may re-enter the Properties and revest title in the City of Chicago. Grantee, at the request of the City of Chicago, covenants to execute and deliver to the

City a reconveyance deed to the Properties to further evidence such

revesting of title. This right of reverter in favor of the City of Chicago shall terminate upon the issuance of a certificate of completion, release or similar instrument by the City of Chicago.

The Grantee acknowledges that if the Grantee develops the Properties with a residential housing project, as defined under and that is subject to Section 2-45-115 of. the Municipal Code of the City (the "2015 Affordable Requirements Ordinance"), the Grantee and such project shall be obligated to comply with the 2015 Affordable Requirements Ordinance.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval.
