### ORDINANCE

#### **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:**

SECTION 1. The City Council finds that the areas described in Section 2 of this ordinance are adversely affected by the over-concentration of businesses licensed to sell package goods within and near the area.

SECTION 2. Section 4-60-023 of the Municipal Code of Chicago is hereby amended by inserting the underscored language as a new subsection 4-60-023(45.87), as follows:

#### **4-60-023 Restrictions on additional licenses.**

Subject to the provisions of subsection 4-60-021 (c), no additional license shall be issued for the sale of alcoholic liquor, for consumption on the premises within the following areas:

*(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)*

(45.87) On the east side of Monticello Avenue, from Grace Street to Waveland Avenue; and on the north side of Waveland Avenue, from Monticello Avenue to Central Park Avenue; and on Elston Avenue, from Central Park Avenue to Irving Park Road.

*(Omitted text is unaffected by this ordinance)*

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication.
