BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICAGO:

SECTION 1. That the Commissioner of Transportation is hereby authorized and directed to install 1 Hour Parking Restriction signs at the below listed locations:

WARD MISCELLEANEOUS:

47 4002 N. Leavitt Street: Repeal ordinance passed 5/9/91, journal page 79 which reads: 4002 N. Leavitt Street (west side) from a point 30 feet north of W. Irving Park Road to a point 95 feet north thereof; One Hour Parking, 11:00am to 8:00pm, Monday through Saturday, by striking the above - (13-01586237) [02013-697]

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force here in after its passage and publication.
