ORDINANCE The University of  
Chicago Acct. No. 63878 - 93  
Permit No. 1140786

*Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Chicago:*

SECTION 1. Permission and authority are hereby given and granted to The University of Chicago, upon the terms and subject to the conditions of this ordinance to maintain and use, as now constructed, one (1) Tunnel(s) under the public right-of-way adjacent to its premises known as 5656 S. Maryland Ave.. Said Tunnel shall be located under and along East 57<sup>th</sup> Street.

Said Tunnel(s) at East 57th Street measure(s):

One (1) at one hundred sixty-five (165) feet in length, and nineteen (19) feet in width for a total of three thousand one hundred thirty-five (3135) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Planning and Development and Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1140786 herein granted the sum of five hundred forty-two (\$542.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.
