



of domestic violence. Up to eight percent of the revenue from the surcharge shall be used for the City's administration and enforcement of Section 4-6-300 and Chapter 4-14 of the Code, as needed. The remaining revenue from the surcharge shall be used to fund housing and related supportive services for victims of domestic violence. The surcharge is a part of the tax imposed by this chapter, and all references to the tax shall be deemed to include the surcharge.
