IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHICA GO:

SECTION I. Title 17 of the Municipal Code of Chicago, the Chicago Zoning Ordinance, is hereby amended by changing all the RT4 Residential Two-Flat, Townhouse and Multi-Unit District symbols and indications as shown on Map No. 3-H in the area bounded by

a line 320 feet southwest of and parallel to North Milwaukee Avenue; the alley next southeast of and parallel to West Evergreen Avenue; a line 345 feet southwest of and parallel to North Milwaukee Avenue; and West Evergreen Avenue,

to those of a RM4.5 Residential Multi-Unit District is hereby established in the area above described.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and due publication.
