

One (1) at one point nine two (1.92) foot in length, and five point seven five (5.75) feet in width for a total of eleven point zero four (11.04) square feet.

One (1) at point seven five (.75) feet in length, and five point three three (5.33) feet in width for a total of four (4) square feet.

One (1) at point five (.5) feet in length, and four point eight three (4.83) feet in width for a total of two point four two (2.42) square feet.

Three (3) at point five (.5) feet in length, and four point seven five (4.75) feet in width for a total of seven point one three (7.13) square feet.

One (1) at point four two (.42) feet in length, and four point seven five (4.75) feet in width for a total of two (2) square feet.

One (1) at point four two (.42) feet in length, and four point eight three (4.83) feet in width for a total of two point zero three (2.03) square feet.

Two (2) at point five eight (.58) feet in length, and four point nine two (4.92) feet in width for a total of five point seven one (5.71) square feet.

Three (3) at point four two (.42) feet in length, and four point six seven (4.67) feet in width for a total of five point eight eight (5.88) square feet.

One (1) at point four two (.42) feet in length, and point five eight (.58) feet in width for a total of point two four (.24) square feet.

The location of said privilege shall be as shown on prints kept on file with the Department of Business Affairs and Consumer Protection and the Office of the City Clerk.

Said privilege shall be constructed in accordance with plans and specifications approved by the Department of Transportation (Office of Underground Coordination).

This grant of privilege in the public way shall be subject to the provisions of Section 10-28-015 and all other required provisions of the Municipal Code of Chicago.

The grantee shall pay to the City of Chicago as compensation for the privilege #1103519 herein granted the sum of four hundred (\$400.00) per annum in advance.

A 25% penalty will be added for payments received after due date.

The permit holder agrees to hold the City of Chicago harmless for any damage, relocation or replacement costs associated with damage, relocation or removal of private property caused by the City performing work in the public way.
